2. In keeping with reference (B), Navy Reserve Officers will
continue to attend an officer leadership course every five years,
taught by the Navy Leadership and Ethics Command (NLEC), which is
the Navy executive agent for officer leadership training.
This policy applies to all drilling Navy Selected Reserve (SELRES),
Volunteer Training Unit (VTU) and Training and Administration of
Reserve (TAR) Officers. TAR officers who do not receive leadership
training every five years while progressing through their community
milestones shall attend one of the courses in paragraph 6.
3. This leadership training requirement is separate from the
requirement for all SELRES officers APPLY-selected for CO/OIC
billets ("K" and "O" coded) to attend the Navy Reserve Unit
Management (NRUM) course.
4. Active Duty for Training (ADT) Schools is the preferred SELRES
funding source for all leadership training courses mandated by
CNRFC. The mission number for officer leadership training can be
found on the CNRFC N7 ADT Schools SharePoint page:
https://private.navyreserve.navy.mil/cnrfc/N-Codes/N7/
ADTSchools/default.aspx. Parent commands will fund training
attendance for assigned TAR officers.
5. Navy Reserve officer leadership courses are taught by Navy
Reserve NLEC facilitators as a mobile training team at Navy Reserve
Activities throughout the Reserve Force. Current Navy Reserve NLEC
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courses that satisfy this five-year leadership training requirement are limited to the following:

6. Officers that completed any AC NLEC leadership course or complete one as part of community pipeline training are current on this
leadership training requirement until five years after completion
of the course. These courses are limited to:

H-7C-0107 Senior Leader Course
P-1B-0005 Executive Officer Leadership Course
P-1B-0004 Command Leadership Course

7. Community-specific leadership training courses do not satisfy the five-year leadership training requirement, since diversity in communities and designators is essential for peer-to-peer interaction and learning.
