## Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP)

### NAVSUP FY15:

The Supply Corps mission is to deliver sustained global logistics capabilities to the Navy and Joint Warfare. Supply Corps Reserve Sailors are the force multipliers assisting the command in meeting its varied challenges on a regular basis, and providing mobilization resources to meet national emergencies.

The Department of the Navy Consolidated Card Program Management Division (DoN CCPMD) within the NAVSUP Corporate Operations division is responsible for the Navy's financial card programs. As the component manager for Government-wide Commercial Purchase Cards (GCPC), Government Travel Credit Cards (GTCC), and Fleet Cards among several others, CCPMD provides their customers with program policy, metrics, training products, assistance with day-to-day operations, and continuous improvement of tools and products.

### Operational Support Snapshot:

- CNRFC N4 logisticians manage over 304 accounts across the Force with an average annual expenditure of \$11,000,000.00. The Purchase Card Program streamlines purchase and payment systems for Navy Reserve Activities and oversees the automated card management, reconciliation, and payment tool.
- CNRFC N4 Logistics Specialists manage 49,355 GTCC accounts with an annual obligation of over \$48,000,000.00. The Travel Card Program provides travelers a safe, effective, convenient, commercially available method to pay for expenses incident to official travel, including local travel. The Travel Card Program includes both Individually Billed Accounts (IBA) and Centrally Billed Accounts (CBA).
