Legal

Judge Advocate General Corps FY15

Mission: The Navy Judge Advocate General's Corps provides solutions, from a military perspective, to legal issues involving military operations, organization, and personnel. They do this wherever and whenever such solutions are required, with primary focus on operations, accountability, Sailor legal readiness, and Navy legal readiness.

- There are 400 Judge Advocates and 162 Legalmen within the Navy Reserve.
- Since FY09, there have been approximately 429 officer mobilizations for contingency operations in Afghanistan, Horn of Africa, Guantanamo Bay, Kuwait and within the U.S.
- **Reserve Law Program**
 - There are approximately 41 Reserve Sailors on ADSW orders (28 officers /13 enlisted) with an additional five officers currently on Definite Recall.
 - Reserve Sailors assigned as military judges have presided over 19 courts martial worldwide so far in FY15.
- **Victim's Legal Counsel (VLC) program** Reserve Sailors continue to provide key support to a critical mission. The Navy Victims' Legal Counsel Program provides survivors of a military sexual offense with a dedicated attorney to help victims understand the investigation and military justice process, guard their legal rights and interests, and obtain additional support in accessing resources that may assist in their recovery.
- **CJTF-HOA Reserve Sailors** in CJTF-HOA provide legal support across the full range of joint operations, including military engagements and personnel recovery operations, and provide humanitarian assistance. Military lawyers in East Africa help CJTF-HOA navigate the complex fiscal authorities available to support much-needed humanitarian assistance to partner nations, including building schools, clinics and hospitals, drilling water wells, and providing medical, dental and veterinary assistance.

- **NR DSO West** legal unit received the 2014 Rear Adm. Hugh H. Howell Jr. Award for Excellence for Best Unit, West Coast. Defense Service Office West provides the highest quality legal representation to Reserve military service members at administrative separation boards and boards of inquiry, in addition to providing advice to active duty and Reserve service members on defense-related topics such as non-judicial punishment.
- **NR RLSO SE** legal unit received the Rear Adm. Hugh H. Howell Jr. Award for Best Unit, East Coast. The mission of Navy Reserve Region Legal Service Office Southeast is to maintain the highest levels of mobilization readiness of all unit members, while providing maximum contributory support to Region Legal Service Office Southeast across the entire spectrum of the RLSO mission-set including command services, military justice and legal assistance.
