Navy Supply Corps

Reserve Supply Community FY16:

The Supply Corps mission is to deliver sustained global logistics capabilities to the Navy and Joint Warfare. Supply Corps Reserve Sailors are the force multipliers, assisting their commands in meeting varied challenges on a regular basis, and providing mobilization resources to meet national emergencies.

Operational Support Snapshot:

- Sailors from Reserve Cargo Handling Battalions within Navy Expeditionary Logistics Support Group (NAVELSG) supported a ship offload to resupply McMurdo Station Antarctica as well as the offload of USNS PLESS at Fleet Logistics Center Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. NAVELSG personnel also deployed to fulfill air cargo requirements and manage fuel farm operations for CTF-53 within the U.S. Central Command area of responsibility.
- Personnel from Reserve elements within NAVSUP Global Logistics Support (GLS) Fleet Logistics Centers (FLC) provided real world logistics support to USS SAMPSON, USNS MERCY and USS INDEPENDENCE. GLS detachments performed fueling operations at NAS Lemoore and provided HAZMAT support to NAS Key West.
- Supply Corps Reserve Sailors specializing in acquisition contracting assisted Naval Supply Systems Command, Defense Logistics Agency, and Defense Contract Management Agency in policy development, contract management, and auditing. This cadre also fulfilled operational contracting requirements in Afghanistan and the Horn of Africa.
- COMPACFLT Reserve Logistics Readiness Support Detachments provide air cargo and passenger manifesting services in support of forward air forces in Atsugi, Japan.
