



A Day in the Navy Reserve May 19, 2012

Today, there are **63,997** Full Time Support and Selected Reserve Sailors in the Navy and **3,880** Reserve Sailors are mobilized providing overseas contingency operation support.

Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet

Forty-three logistics readiness reserve members from NR Commander U.S. Pacific Fleet 120 (HQ), NR COMPACFLT 219 and one NR C3F logistic readiness center unit provided a total of 670 man-days of support for Exercise *Terminal Fury* 2012, an annual contingency response exercise in the Pacific Command AOR. Members provided 24/7 watchstanding support to the PACFLT N4 staff as Battle Watch Captains and assistants as well as providing functional area expertise in such disciplines as ordnance, fuels, maintenance and engineering, medical, transportation, and mortuary affairs. Through cross-training and aggressive active/reserve component integration, the transition from peacetime operations to a wartime scenario is transparent.

Naval Air Systems Command

Navy Diver 1st Class Daniel Griffith assigned to 3rd Marine Aircraft Wing (Forward) Headquarters at Camp Leatherneck, Afghanistan is presented with the 2011 NAVAIR Reserve Program Sailor of the Year. NAVAIR reservists were recalled to active duty to support and manage Forward Deployed Combat Repair (FDCR) Detachment Afghanistan. FDCR provides on-site, in-theater, depot-level maintenance and battle-damage repair to Marine Corps and Navy aircraft.

NR EXP LOG (including Detachment A) completed the final draft of the Operation *Tomodachi* lessons learned report for NAVAIR 6.0 during their reserve drill weekend. The draft completion is a culmination of more than 1,500 man-hours of effort including a complete top-down review of NAVAIR 6.0 mission efforts at nine different sites. The report provides NAVAIR 6.0 the framework for future radiological reclamation capabilities for the Naval Aviation Enterprise.

An NR officer from the NAVAIR Digital Kill Chain unit is participating in Exercise *Terminal Fury* working through multiple levels of strategic planning and operational battle watch scenarios. The high-operating tempo exercise in Hawaii has over 7,000 augmentees participating in a joint service planning training opportunity.

An NR officer from NAVAIR Digital Kill Chain is providing support to the P-8 program's Integrated Test Team (ITT). During two weeks of Annual Training, the member researched and documented the process required for Navy Reservists to provide in-flight test engineering support onboard P-8 aircraft. Reserve support to the ITT will contribute to the P-8A program reaching initial operational capability

An NR officer from the NAVAIR Reserve Program unit supporting the Program Executive Office (Tactical) is on AT orders today, assigned to PMA-213. He is leading an operational impact analysis effort regarding the AN/SPN-46 radar. The system provides course and glideslope information from an aircraft carrier to an aircraft on final approach and is also capable of landing aircraft for a fully automated, hands-off approach and recovery.

NMCB 23 Detachment Honduras Seabees are building a two-room schoolhouse and a four-room medical clinic in La Lima, Honduras as part of the U.S. Army South Exercise *Beyond the Horizon Guatemala 2012* which runs through July. Today, they completed forming and installed matting for remaining sidewalks, installed door frames and hung doors and set roof trusses.

Navy Reserve Frigate USS *McClusky* (FFG 41) is underway in the Eastern Pacific with an embarked U.S. Coast Guard Law Enforcement Detachment, conducting Countering Transnational Organized Crime (C-TOC) Operations in the U.S. Southern Command Area of Responsibility.
