RMKS/1. This message announces common military training (CMT)
requirements for fiscal year (FY) 2025 for the Navy Reserve. In
line with reference (a), the Navy has minimized the number of
mandatory CMT topics to empower commanders to decide what
training their personnel should receive and how often they should
receive it. Commanding officers (CO) should review the command
discretion CMT list to determine the frequency and method of

additional training appropriate for their command.

2. FY-25 Mandatory CMT Requirements

- a. Mandatory CMT must be completed by all military personnel.
- b. The following mandatory CMT is required to be completed in FY-25:

- (1) DoD Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) Training.
- (2) NCIS Counterintelligence and Insider Threat Awareness and Reporting.
- (3) DoD Cyber Awareness Challenge 2025.
- (4) Operations Security (OPSEC) Annual Training.
- (5) Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) Awareness.
- (6) Suicide Prevention.
- (7) Records Management in the DoN: everyone's Responsibility.
- (8) Harassment Prevention and Military Equal Opportunity.
- (9) Antiterrorism Level 1 Awareness Training.

3. FY-25 Command Discretion CMT

- a. Situational CMT Topics are not mandatory for all Navy personnel. Instead, they are available for individual unit training as decided by Commanding Officers. This approach empowers Commanders to optimize training needs unique to situational and operational requirements.

- b. COs may assign the following topics at their discretion:

- (1) Combating Trafficking in Persons.
- (2) Domestic Violence for All Hands.
- (3) Substance Abuse.
- (4) Financial Readiness.
- (5) DoN Privacy Act Training.
- (6) Tactical Combat Casualty Care.
- (7) Countering Extremist Activity.
- (8) Crew Endurance and Fatigue Management.
- (9) Foreign Malign Influence (FMI) Training and Awareness.
- (10) Traumatic Brain Injury Training for Service Members.

4. Get Real Get Better (GRGB) Training Requirement

- a. All TAR Officers and TAR Enlisted Sailors are required to complete GRGB training by 31 December 2024.
- b. All Selected Reserve (SELRES) Sailors are required to complete GRGB training no later than 31 December 2025.
- c. GRGB Training can be completed in person. In person training should be entered in FLTMS utilizing CIN: GRGB-0789.
