1. PURPOSE.

a. MOBEX 26-1: Reserve Component (RC) Movement Tracking Table-Top Exercise (TTX). Per reference (a), this EXORD directs Commander, Navy Reserve Force (CNRF) N36 to plan, coordinate and execute MOBEX 26-1. Supporting MOBEX stakeholders include CNRF (N6, N9 and N10), U.S. Navy Pay and Personnel Support Center (NPPSC), Navy Passenger Transportation Office (NAVPTO), Navy Reserve Region Readiness and Mobilization Command (REDCOM) Norfolk, and Navy Reserve Center (NRC) Norfolk. MOBEX 26-1 commences 28 October 2025 and ends 29 October 2025. MOBEX 26-1 will be held via Microsoft Teams. Aforementioned commands are specifically directed to:

(1) Participate in MOBEX 26-1 tabletop (TTX) discussions that will be held from 28-29 October 2025.

(2) Participants shall ensure applicable subject matter experts (SMEs) from their respective staffs to participate in MOBEX 26-1 TTX.

2. Background.

a. In May 2025, Adaptive Mobilization (AM) was approved by the Deputy Chief of Naval Operations, Manpower, Personnel, training in reference (b). AM was designed to satisfy both steady-state and mass activation requirements and encompasses all processes of distributed activation (DA), distributed mobilization (DM), distributed de-mobilization (DDM) and distributed de-activation (DDA).

b. Improving the Navy's ability to mass-mobilize the Navy Reserve 50,000 RC Sailors in 30 days (50K/30D) and refining resources to meet this capability is crucial. Incorporating frequent rehearsals to hone the skills are necessary to ensure success. CNRF regularly conducts MOBEXs to test the Navy's ability to mass-activate RC Sailors and units. These stress tests have solidified lessons learned, leading to significant process improvements over the last four years.

c. In FY-26, CNRF directed the planning and execution of three MOBEXs to develop, test, and evaluate AM processes per reference (a). The force must continue to execute and leverage readiness improvement initiatives incorporated in references (b), (c), (d) and (e).

d. FY-26 MOBEXs are designed to evaluate the progress of readiness improvement across the force as well as develop and improve AM processes. MOBEX 26-1 is the first tranche of exercises in the series for FY-26.

3. Commander's Intent.

a. CNRF executes AM to mobilize designated personnel for both (1) mass activation in support of strategic competition as well as (2) steady-state and emergent ad hoc augmentation. The purpose of MOBEX 26-1 is to conduct system analysis on RC Movement Tracking and identify parameters for system application.

b. MOBEX 26-1 TTX Objectives.

(1) NRA-level SELRES readiness tracking prior to mass mobilization.

(2) Batch passenger reservation request (PRR) submissions during mass mobilization.

(3) Establish a system to track RC movement from ready load date (RLD) to the designated reception point.

c. Participation is directed by CNRF and mandatory for all commands listed in para 1.a of this EXORD.

4. Execute.

(c) Review Mass Deployment Transportation Request template.

(d) Review NAVPTO Transportation Request training.

(e) Review Mass Activation Physical Movement of Sailors powerpoint presentation.

(2) Evaluate Navy Reserve Activity command roles in the execution of the passenger travel requests for mass activation.

(3) Evaluate process duration or timeline for completing the required actions in the batch transportation request process.

(4) Evaluate RC Sailor physical movements from place of last entry to active duty (PLEAD) to designated reception point for mass activation.

(5) Participants are encouraged to arrive equipped with questions, concerns and recommendations for improving the administrative screening process during the execution of MOBEX 26-1TTX.

5. Administration and Logistics. This EXORD does not appropriate funds. Conduct events on a not-to-interfere basis with real-world operations and mobilizations.
