TRUIC to UMUIC SHIFT

Aligning Reserve Sailor performance

By Aug. 1, 2022 all FITREPS and EVALS will be administered by the Reserve Sailor's supported command's Navy Reserve Readiness Unit (UMUIC). The change will affect more than 14,000 Sailors currently receiving evaluations from their Administrative Unit (TRUIC).

This new UMUIC construct supports the Navy Reserve's singular focus on warfighting readiness and will ensure our Reserve Sailors are engaged with their supported command in order to be fully trained in their mobilization billets.
