RMKS/1. As announced, the 2026 Navy Reserve Fighting Instructions (NRFI) have been approved and published.

2. The 2026 NRFI (reference (b)) supersedes all prior Navy Reserve Strategic Guidance. It builds upon the U.S. Navy Fighting Instructions in reference (a) by maximizing warfighting readiness through three core tenets: Foundry (training), Fleet (modernization), and Fight (integration).

3. The ultimate goal of this directive is to guarantee the rapid mobilization of 50,000 operationally ready Sailors within 30 days to fight and win on "Day One." All Navy Reserve leadership and personnel are directed to read, understand, and implement the NRFI to ensure seamless integration and immediate activation capability.
