1. Purpose

a. This message promulgates Commander, Navy Reserve Force (CNRF) guidance for BBSS Phase 3 implementation per refs (a) and (b). BBSS Phase 3 is directed to be executed per refs (c) and (d).

2. Background

a. IAW ref (b), the Navy Reserve Force will have the capability to activate up to 50,000 SELRES Sailors within 30 days of a SECWAR order or CNO N3N5N7 validation of a service requirement to provide Combatant Commanders (CCDRs) and Fleets the predictability necessary for effective operational planning for contingency.

3. Commander's Intent

a. The Navy Reserve Force will complete and maintain medical and administrative BBSS IAW refs (a) through (e). In support of the Adaptive Mobilization (AM) Force Activation Process, this message directs the execution of BBSS Phase 3 to screen all remaining SELRES

Sailors assigned to a Tier 1 or Tier 2 mobilization billet per ref (d).

(1) Tier 1 screening refers to requirements for overseas, remote, and operational assignments. See ref (d) Figure 1-1 and Figure 1-2 for specific mandatory screening documents.

(2) Tier 2 screening refers to requirements for expeditionary assignments. See ref (d) Figure 1-1 and Figure 1-2 for specific mandatory screening documents.

4. Execute. BBSS Phase 3 is directed to be completed by 30Sep26. Starting 01Jul26, NRAs will screen all remaining Navy SELRES assigned to a Tier 1 or Tier 2 mobilization billet per ref (d) who were not screened during BBSS Phase 2.

a. NRAs will:

(1) Ensure completion of all Tier 1 and Tier 2 screening required documents for each of their assigned, eligible SELRES.

(a) Tier 1 and Tier 2 mobilization billet assignments are identified via the ZipServe Activation Screening portal, link here:

(b) Required screening documents per ref (d) are to be completed and submitted per the following guidance:

i. Pre-Deployment Medical Screening. SELRES/NRAs are to download the assigned DD Form 2807-1, and NAVMED 1300/1 (Tier 1) or NAVMED 1300/4 (Tier 2) medical screening forms directly from CNRF N9 Medical Process Management Portal (MedProc), complete IAW CNRF N9 guidance at the link below, and upload the completed documents back via the BBSS Phase 3 link on CNRF N9 MedProc. Link here: <https://sha.repoint.navyreserve.navy.mil/cnrfc/N-Codes/N9/MedProc/SitePages/Landing.aspx>.

ii. Pre-Deployment Administrative Screening. SELRES/NRAs are

to download the assigned NAVPERS 1300/22 RC Tier 1 or RC Tier 2 screening checklist directly from the ZipServe Activation Screening portal, complete Section 1, and upload back to the ZipServe Activation Screening portal. Link here: <https://locker.private.navyreserve.navy.mil/zipserve/home>.

(2) Track and report completion of SELRES screening using the BBSS Phase 3 Activation Screening Tool. Upon completion and electronic submission per para 4.a.(1), enter the vetting completion date, vetting individual name, and suitability determination for each member screened.

i. The BBSS Phase 3 Activation Screening Tool is for NRA tracking of ref (d) screening requirements. Navy Reserve Readiness Units (NRRUs) will provide updates to the NRA for respective requirements, but will not be granted direct access to the BBSS Phase 3 Activation Screening Tool itself.

b. NRAs will use all available medical screening resources as directed in ref (e).

(1) Adaptive Mobilization Medical Units (AMMUs) from each respective Navy Reserve Region Readiness and Mobilization Command (REDCOM) will support by conducting the required screening for

SELRES per ref (d).

c. Per para 4.a.(1)(b)i., selected NRA Medical Department representatives will track and report to CNRF N9 (via their ISIC Medical Department) on the disposition of any potentially deployment-limiting conditions identified as a result of the required screening i.e., whether the condition has been resolved or if an MRR, TNPQ, or LOD packet has been initiated.

d. Questions regarding the BBSS Phase 3 MedProc and ZipServe Activation Screening portal at the NRA level will be routed to their ISIC, and higher to CNRF/C N9 for MedProc and CNRF/C N36 for the ZipServe Activation Screening portal as necessary.

(2) Any updated guidance will be promulgated via the CNRF N3 AM Action Officer Teleconference held on the first and third Wednesdays of the month.

5. Amplifying Guidance.

a. Medical and administrative BBSS supports warfighting readiness to achieve 50K/30D.

b. If necessary to accomplish required screening items, SELRES

Sailors will be placed in a qualified status (drill status, annual training (AT), active duty for training (ADT), etc.) per ref (e). SELRES Sailors' leadership will prioritize drill weekend tasks, re-scheduled AT, ADT, etc. to complete the screening within the required deadlines.

6. Clarifications.

a. BBSS Phase 3 is specifically directed ISO the AM Force Activation Process via the Mobilization-to-Billet Pathway. Individual Augmentation (IA) mobilization screening will continue to be conducted IAW direction provided in the body of IA mobilization orders, and IAW ref (f).

b. BBSS Phase 3 End State Goal: NRAs screen all remaining SELRES assigned to a Tier 1 and Tier 2 mobilization billet IAW ref (d).

c. NRAs will continue executing all previously directed BBSS until complete per ref (a).
