RMKS/1. This is a solicitation for Training and Administration of
the Reserve (TAR) Unrestricted Line (URL) officers in the grades of
O-3 to O-5 to apply for the CY 2028 Navy Legislative Fellowship Program.

This message addresses the initial screening process for Reserve Component
(RC)

applicants to ensure alignment with Reference (a) prior to final submission
to

the Office of Legislative Affairs (OLA). Upon completion of the fellowship,
RC nominees are screened and expected to fill one of four TAR legislative
billets in a utilization follow-on tour.

2. Program Overview. The Legislative Fellowship is a Department of War
program providing a full-time, year-long assignment in a Congressional
personal office (House or Senate). Participants will draft legislation,
meet with constituents and senior military leaders, prepare for hearings,
analyze public policy, and report to the Representative or Senator.

Navy Office of Legislative Affairs (OLA) administers the Navy component of
the program,

supported by OPNAV N0952 (Director of Legislative Affairs for the Chief of
Navy Reserve).

The program starts with reporting to the Navy OLA for orientation November
through December,

and then embedding with the assigned office in January.

Upon completion of the fellowship in the following December the fellow will
return to the Navy

Reserve to complete the follow-on assignment requirement.

3. Eligibility & Requirements.

Participation is open to Reserve Component TAR URL officers in the permanent grades of O-3

through O-5. The selection process will focus on individual performance, promotion potential,

academic and subspecialty qualifications, needs of the Navy, and

availability for follow-on

assignment. Officers with permanent change of station orders already issued will not be considered.

All officer applicants must contact their detailers for counseling on the career impact of

participation in the Legislative Fellowship Program. Officers should plan for an immediate follow-on

utilization tour or assignment upon completion of the fellowship, in line with Ref (a).

Must be available for PCS to Washington, D.C., in November 2028.

4. Application Process. Reserve Component applicants shall submit applications via e-mail to

bobby.h.hsu.mil@us.navy.mil no later than 05 October 2026. OCNR will rank,

endorse the packages and

forward to OLA for final selection. Ref (a) specifies the contents of the application package.

5. Selection Timeline.

December: OCNR ranks and endorses packages

January-February: OLA conducts administrative screening and interviews

March-April: OLA makes Selection notifications
