Subj: NAVY RESERVE FORCE COMMAND ASSESSMENT SCHEDULE AND GUIDE

1. Purpose. Per reference (a), this notice provides a CA Schedule and CA Guide.
2. Objective. The objective of the Command Assessment (CA) Schedule is to provide notice to Commander, Navy Reserve Force (CNRF) Inspector General (IG) and echelon 3 and 4 commanders to plan and execute triennial CA events per reference (a). The release of this notice signals a period of in-depth review and feedback from echelon 3 and 4 leaders to enable CNRF IG to further refine the CA process to prioritize warfighting readiness.
3. Action. Requirements are provided per reference (a). CNRF IG will coordinate with echelon 3 and 4 commanders to execute the CA Schedule as planned in enclosure (1). Additionally, CNRF IG will maintain the current CA Guide with applicable program checklists on the Navy Reserve Homeport located at the following web site: https://private.navyreserve.navy.mil/cnrfc/Special_Assistants/N002/CAP%20Instructions/Forms/AllItems.aspx. Lastly, CNRF IG recommends that echelon 4 commanders assess all of the Mission Readiness program areas and 20% or more of the Mission Support and Sailor and Civilian Support program areas during echelon 5 CA events.
4. Reports. The reporting requirements are provided per reference (a).
5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.
6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice is in effect for 1 year or until it is superseded by another notice, whichever occurs first.
