FY-11 Mandatory Information Assurance Awareness Training (IAAT) is now loaded on NKO <https://www.nko.navy.mil/portal/home> under e-Learning -> Mandatory Training -> DoD Information Assurance Awareness V9: FY 2011 Department of Defense required IA Awareness training. Results are loaded to FLTMPs when IAAT is completed using NKO so there is no requirement to print and turn in a hard copy to the Force IAM.

Reminder for Revised HYT Gates for E1-E6 SELRES Personnel. This is a reminder of the revised High Year Tenure (HYT) gates that will impact SELRES Sailors. Personnel who reach their HYT Gate must be removed from a SELRES status by the end of the month their HYT date is reached. Refer to MPM 1160-130 for SELRES personnel options and for command administrative responsibilities.

E3 - E5 SELRES The revised HYT gates for E3 through E5 personnel becomes effective on 1 February 2011. All E3 - E5 personnel who attain HYT status on 1 February 2011 as a result of the revised HYT gates must be transferred to the VTU, IRR, or retired Reserve (with or without pay) NLT 28 February 2011.

E6 SELRES The revised HYT gates for E6 personnel go into effect on 1 October 2011. The February 2011 advancement exam for E6 personnel is the last exam opportunity before the revised HYT gates go into effect. Those E6 personnel who attain HYT status on 1 October 2011 as a result of the revised gates must be transferred to VTU, IRR, or Retired Reserve (with or without pay) NLT 31 October 2011.

The revised HYT gate changes are expected to impact many SELRES personnel. Command leadership is reminded to ensure personnel affected by the SELRES HYT gate changes are properly aware of their exam opportunities.

Around the Force

USFF Shows Support For Navy Reserve Civil Service Employees. VADM Debbink visited RADM Little and his staff at CNRFC in Norfolk, VA all day Monday, receiving the latest status on many of the FY11 strategic initiatives as part of our Navy Reserve Strategic Plan. Solid progress is being made on all 12 initiatives for this year. Also Monday, ADM Harvey signed an ESGR Statement of Support pledging his support of the Navy Reserve Sailors and their families. The signing represents the longstanding commitment that ADM Harvey and USFF have displayed consistently over the years to those employed as civil servants by USFF and its subordinate commands.

11th C-40A Delivered/Platform Enables Neo Efforts In Egypt. The 11th C-40A was delivered 28 January and flown to VR-58 at NAS Jacksonville where it will reside until the completion of the VR-56 hangar in Oceana. The capabilities of this platform were recently on full display as VR-57 launched from Bahrain to effectively transport Fleet Anti-terrorism Security Team (FAST) members and Country Surveillance Assessment Team (CSAT) members from the Combined Forces Special Operations Component Command (CFSOCC) to Cairo International Airport. From there they executed Non-Combatant Evacuation Operations (NEO) for American citizens from the U.S. embassy during the country's ongoing unrest.

CNR Speaks at USNA Leadership Symposium. VADM Debbink had the distinct privilege of participating in the 2011 Annual USNA Leadership Conference. Panel discussions, speeches and breakout sessions were centered around this year's theme, "Leader Development: The Cycle of Success", with a diverse list of participants including GM Chairman and CEO, Mr. Daniel F. Akerson, Former White Press Secretary Ari Fleischer and keynote speaker Mr. Marcus Buckingham. It was a fantastic opportunity to engage with our future leaders and civilian and military leaders.
